

Summary of Payments for Australian Apprentices

The federal government has streamlined the incentive program to make it simpler and to allocate the funding to industries that are considered a priority to building the Australian economy.

The following payments apply where the commencement or recommencement date of the Australian Apprentices is on/after the 1st of July 2022.

Australian Apprentice Training Support Payment:

- \$5000 in total for full-time Australian Apprentices; or
- \$2500 in total for part-time Australian Apprentices.

Paid in instalments of:

- \$1250 at the 6, 12, 18 and 24 month points for full-time Australian Apprentices; or
- \$625 at the 6, 12, 18 and 24 month points for part-time Australian Apprentices.

Standard Eligibility Criteria:

Where the Australian Apprentice is:

- Commencing, recommencing or an existing worker;
- Undertaking a Certificate III, IV, Diploma or Advance Diploma;
- Undertaking a qualification and occupational outcome stated on [Appendix A: Australian Apprenticeship Priority List](#);
- Not claiming other 'wage subsidies'. (Note: Trade Support Loan and Living Away From Home Allowance are not 'wage subsidies'.); and

Where the Employer is:

- Registered for [Single Touch Payroll](#) with the ATO or has ATO Exemption, and therefore wage evidence is available through Single Touch Payroll.

Trade Support Loan:

- This is a loan to assist with the cost of living whilst undertaking an Australian Apprenticeship, and **must be repaid**.
- Repayments are made through the ATO and can be repaid in bulk payments or a percentage deducted each year when you lodge your Tax Return.
- Lifetime Limit: \$22,890.

Standard Eligibility Criteria:

Where the Australian Apprentice is undertaking:

- Certificate III or IV qualification that leads to an occupation on the [National Skills Needs List](#) (Appendix B) and to a qualification on the [Trade Support Loans Qualifications List](#); or
- Certificate II – IV Agriculture qualification on the [Trade Support Loans Qualifications List](#); or
- Certificate II – IV Horticulture qualification on the [Trade Support Loans Qualifications List](#) with a workplace postcode on the [Rural & Regional Postcode List](#) (Appendix D).
